Tuition Discounts Available:

- **Early Pay Discount** - \$200.00 off if paid in full when paid three weeks of receiving your contract date up to May 29th
- **Longevity Discount** - \$50.00 off for all CV or Spirit Alumni (maximum discount is \$50, including if you are a vet of both groups), \$100 off for CV gold stars (6th year), \$150 off for ten-year CV members.
- **Recruitment Discount** - \$50 per person up to 3 people (if recruit makes it past the first show) this discount will be applied to the 2022 fundraising fee.
- **Scholarships** - Applications are accepted late May and issued in mid-June. Exact dates and details will be announced later. Scholarship recipients will be contacted in June and awarded monies on their CorpsData account. Scholarships are partial scholarships and will not pay all tuition.

Fee Schedule

Brass & Percussion –

1. \$100 for Registration Fee and Audition Packet.
2. \$1575 Tuition – \$100 payment every camp weekend beginning on January 8, 2022 with final payment due by June 26, 2022.

Guard –

1. \$100 for Registration Fee and Guard Uniform.
2. \$1575 Tuition – \$150 payment every camp weekend beginning on January 8, 2022 with final payment due by July 10, 2022.

If a member falls behind on 2 tuition payments, they could be moved to alternate status and potentially not allowed to participate in CV rehearsals. Members that have not paid in full by due date may be subject to dismissal, or not permitted to travel to the DCA World Championship over Labor Day Weekend.

Other Costs

Subject to Change

We separate these few items from the total tuition amount as many members have these items already.

- Brass and Percussion may have an additional fee to cover their under shirt for the uniform; after the season this belongs to the member (unless otherwise stated).

- Housing costs at Championships are included in the above fees. Housing may be at a local high school or at a hotel. If the corps proper is housed at a high school, there is no additional cost or reimbursement to the member. Also, if the corps proper is housed at a high school and the member chooses to house at a hotel, that is their own cost not included in the fees above and transportation is also their own cost.
- Other items not covered as part of your tuition and fees:
 - Food at rehearsals and trips (unless otherwise told it will be provided by the corps).
 - Marching show shoes (\$45).
 - Transportation to and from camp or local area shows.
- An optional member jacket will be available for purchase at limited dates throughout the season. We will make announcements about cost and deadlines prior to placing orders.

Fundraising

Fundraising – fundraising@atlantacv.org

A Fundraising Fee of **\$250** has been implemented for the 2022 season. Membership is asked to participate in active fundraising for the corps during the 2022 season. Fundraising efforts will go towards reducing membership tuition. Fundraising (\$50 Registration fee and \$50 Audition Packet Fee not included). The net profit earned will be split between the member and the corps with the percentage split announced for each fundraiser prior to its start. Fundraising benefits both the member and the corps. Anyone having trouble making the scheduled tuition payments is expected to participate in fundraisers. *Below are some **examples** of past fundraisers that CV has offered. We are currently working out details for the 2022 season.*

- **Bed Sheet Sales** – Atlanta CV does a wonderful sheet sale fundraiser where we sell sets of bed sheets.
- **Raffle Ticket Sales** – Atlanta CV does multiple raffle tickets sales for items such as iPads, Fitbits, Yeti Coolers, and much, much, more. They are spread out throughout the year.
- **Waffle House Coupon Books** - Members work to sell \$5 Waffle House Coupon Books (Coupons valued at \$20) to earn fundraising dollars.

If a parent plans to make the payments for the financial obligations of their child, we encourage the parent's email address to be linked to the child's account.
